Float Fly May 20

May Float Fly will be at the Swim Beach area. NOTE: Renaissance Faire is open, and inbound traffic will be heavy after 9 AM so plan to arrive early.

We have scheduled Float Flys for every other month. If you do not have a float plane, now is the time to get one. See the SFDRCM website for information on float flying and buying or building floats.

It is important to obey all rules so that we do not jeopardize our privileges at the lake.

Members and Invited guests only allowed to fly. Current AMA card required.

Spectators always welcome. You pay your own park entry fee \$5 per car seniors, \$10 per car others. Pay club \$10 landing fee and lunch. Flying from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. or earlier if activity slows.

Driving on the walkways to load and unload only is ok, but no parking. Drive SLOWLY and carefully. Obey any instructions by lifeguards or park
